Graphic Design

The graphic designer is a professional whose activity is aimed at the use of graphic language to create messages and communicate content of a diverse nature using a variety of media and for different channels of communication.

The main areas of professional activity are:

- Corporate and visual identity.
- Editorial design.
- Graphic production.
- Packaging design.
- Art Direction for Advertising.
- Audio visual design. TV Graphics.
- Multi media design.
- Interactive design, web design.
- Environmental designer: graphics & communication applied to space.
- Designing teaching materials.
- Research and teaching.

▲ Qualifications

The Advanced Art Qualifications in Design taught at the Jerez School of Art are Official Advanced Qualifications and consist of 240 ECTS credits divided into eight terms and a duration of four years. Each credit corresponds to 30 hours of tuition. The successful completion of the 240 ECTS credits leads to the qualification of Arts Degree majoring in Graphic Design or Interior Design, with recognition and certification of university credits. Equivalent of a University Degree, according to article 57.4 of the Education Organic Law 2/2006 of May 3rd.

Article 18. Issue.

Royal Decree 1614/2009, of October 26th, which establishes the regulation of advanced art courses governed by Article 18 of Organic Law 2/2006, May 3rd, related to Education. With the aim of promoting the movement of Spanish undergraduates and graduates within the European Higher Education Area, the education authorities will issue, together with the qualification, the corresponding European Supplement to the Degree.

First semester: September to February. Applications from 15th April to 15th June.

Second semester: February to June Applications from 15 October to 15 December.
